## FAQs

Q: How often should I have my gutters cleaned?

A: On average, our customers are about equally split between a once-a-year and twice-a-year cleaning schedule. Depending on the amount and type of nearby trees, more or less frequent cleaning may be appropriate.

Q: Is gutter protection a good choice for my home's gutters?

A: As a rule of thumb, we tell our customers that if they plan on living in the home for at least an additional 3.5 years, then it typically makes financial sense to invest in gutter protection. On average, the 3.5 year mark is where the savings of avoided cleanings surpasses the initial expense of the gutter protection.

Q: Why wouldn't I buy one of your competitors' gutter protection products that come with a lifetime maintenance-free warranty?

A: 1) They are very expensive! 2) No product in this part of the country can truly claim to be 100% maintenance free. We've had almost a dozen calls from people who purchased expensive systems and had performance issues with them just a few years after installation. In several cases, the companies who installed them were not even in business any longer.

Q: What is the best time of year to have tree work performed?

A: If a tree is being completely removed or if you are just having dead wood removed, then any time of year is fine. If, however, you are having sizable live limbs removed, then it is generally better for the tree's health to wait until winter.

Q: How did you guys get into this line of work?

A: Most of us come from high-level rock climbing backgrounds. There is a lot of skill and equipment transfer and we enjoy working outdoors.
